



Yes, you do have a dog of breeding quality. However, if you are not active in showing or working your dog, think very carefully about your reason for breeding. Breeding should be done to Improve the Breed, not "so the kids can see puppies being born," or because you "want a puppy from her," and NEVER to make money selling puppies! Do not breed out of greed!!

Is your dog healthy and certified (ofa, cerf) free of genetic disease?

Does your dog fit the breed standard?

Does your dog have a stable temperament?

Are there at least four titled dogs (conformation, obedience, tracking, field, etc.) in the last three generations?
